Pickaway SWCD is excited to announce our annual Soil & Water Stewardship Poster Contest! This year's theme is: **“Where would we BEE without Pollinators?”**



Rules

1. Poster size must be 14" x 22" (half poster) to be considered for state awards-teachers may submit 8.5" x 11" if they wish to have their posters only compete on a local level.
2. Theme "Life in the Soil: Dig Deeper" must be on your poster.
3. No photographs or pictures of commercial origin are permitted.
4. Poster must be created by an individual student. 1 entry per student.
5. Tape entry form to the back of your poster. Entry forms available from your teacher or www.pickawayswcd.org.
6. Colorful posters are best! Use crayons, felt pens, paints, watercolors, or grease pencils. If using colored pencils, make sure they are bold colors. Avoid thin-lined, light-colored artwork.
7. Posters will be judged in 4-6 or 7-9 grade-level categories.
8. The posters will be evaluated on the following criteria:
 - 50% Conservation Message (artist uses correct theme)
 - 30% Visual Effectiveness
 - 10% Universal Appeal
 - 10% Originality
9. Posters due to the Pickaway Soil & Water Conservation District office at 110 Island Road, Suite D, Circleville by **4:30 p.m. on Friday, March 6.**
