2023 Donald E. Minor Memorial Scholarship

The Pickaway Soil and Water Conservation District is offering at least three \$1,000 scholarships to Pickaway County high school seniors who will be majoring in Agriculture or Natural Resources, and/or students who have been Student Affiliate Members for at least three years. The scholarship is for the purpose of continuing higher education at a two or four-year college or university.

Qualifications

Applications will be accepted from students meeting the following qualifications:

1. Will be attending a 2- or 4-year college or university in the Fall of 2023
2. Must be a senior at a Pickaway County high school or home school
3. Must be an Agriculture or Natural Resource related major and/or has been a Student Affiliate Member for at least three years

Condition of the Scholarship

The \$1,000 award will be used toward students' tuition and fees and will be awarded in two payments (\$500 for fall semester and \$500 for spring semester). Once the student receives their first semester bill in the fall (and also second semester bill going into 2024), it will be their responsibility to turn a copy of each bill into Pickaway SWCD. We will then submit payment directly to your school's registrar's office.
