NWSG Herbicide Information

Plateau (imazapic) – Can be used Pre- or Post-emergent. Has approximately 2 weeks of residual action per ounce. Use 4 oz/acre in crop field or prepared seedbed, 6 oz/acre in fescue/CRP/sod. Follow label instructions. Plant only Plateau-tolerant grass and forb species. May be difficult to obtain.

Journey – This is a pre-mix of Glyphosate and Plateau (imazapic). This can only be used PRE-EMERGENT. Plant only Plateau-tolerant grass and forb species. General recommendations: Apply 10.7 oz/acre (equivalent to 4 oz of Plateau) in crop field or prepared seedbed, 15.0 oz/acre (equivalent to 6 oz. of Plateau) in fescue/CRP/sod. Refer to the product label for information. Should be available through distributors, co-ops, etc.
